



ISA EVENT ANNOUNCERS CODE OF CONDUCT

ISA Code of Conduct outlines the standard of behavior expected of all members of Federations that are members of the International Surfing Association (ISA), as well as all Officials employed or volunteering with the ISA. It is a formal statement of the values and ethical standards that guide individuals in sport. It is a set of principles and norms to which sportspeople and officials can be held accountable when representing their country or officiating at any ISA event. The Code is used as a point of reference when dealing with disciplinary procedures against members or officials.

I will:

- Refrain from the use of profane, insulting, harassing or otherwise offensive language or behavior in the conduct of my duties.
- Never speak negatively against the event, the sponsors and the ISA
- Avoid partial opinions in my capacity as an announcer
- Neither add to nor omit anything from the Announcer's script
- Attend all the required meetings
- Report any problem or inconvenience to the ISA Contest Director
- Avoid or put an end to any situation that threatens the safety of the athletes.
- Strive to maintain a healthy atmosphere and environment for competition.
- Never condone/tolerate unacceptable conduct toward officials, athletes or spectators.
- Remain open to constructive criticism; show respect and consideration for different points of view.
- Obtain proper training and continue to upgrade skills.
- Consistently display high personal standards and project a favorable image of the sport and officiating and uphold the international standards.
- Abstain from the use of tobacco products and alcoholic beverages in public working with officials and athletes.
- Maintain sobriety and other appropriate behaviors prior to, during and after hours during an ISA event.
- Never advocate or condone the use of drugs, tobacco, alcohol or other banned substances or methods.
- Arrive on time ready to complete the duties that I have been appointed to perform.
- Behave in accordance with the highest standards acceptable by the ISA and myself.
